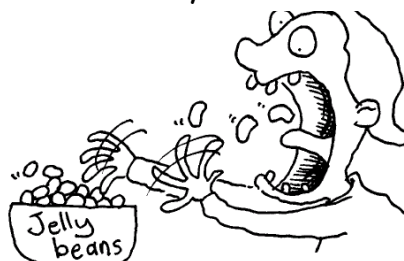
Problem Solving
