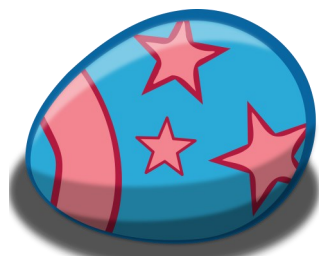
Easter Egg Bingo
