This week your child will bring home a short interim report from their classteacher. The purpose of the report is to update parents with their child's progress and their most recent teacher assessments. Children in Y2-Y6 will also have tests results on their reports for reading and maths. Since children are judged by their performance on tests at the end of KS2 we felt it was useful to also share test results that we use to inform teacher assessments. These tests may give a different view of your child's performance and must be kept in perspective and read alongside the teacher assessment and personal comment.

Reports will also give you as parents an indication if your child is requiring more support and how you can support their learning at home.

Education is a partnership between parents and teachers, we **NEED** your support to be successful in educating your child.

Parents Evening letters will be coming home shortly for parent sessions where you will be able to discuss your child's progress in more detail. Of course if you would like to see a member of staff before then, staff will always make themselves available and appointments can be made through the office. Parents are always welcome in school or on the phone.

World Book Day ~ Wednesday 6th March




This year we are asking for children to come to school dressed as their favourite book character from.....
