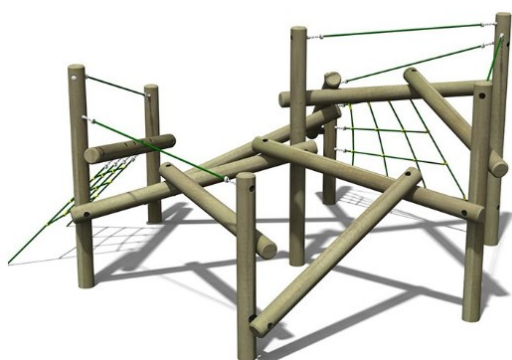


Christmas Elves are on sale for £1.50 to raise money for Derian House
