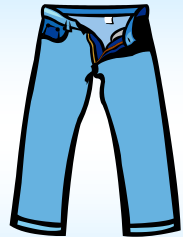
Please make sure all uniform is labelled. Clothes will be returned to the correct class and your child if they are labelled. Thank you for your support

Clubs start on Monday 14th September. Your child will be informed about their clubs on Friday this week.

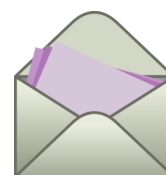
Library Club
