The Oaks CP School ~ Uniform Policy

At The Oaks we take great pride in wearing our school uniform. Our uniform is an important and valued feature of the school's traditions and ethos and contributes to the high standards set by the school.

Our school colours are royal blue and gold. Uniform can be obtained through our school supplier, Mr Lucas, who provides a 'Home Service' and can be contacted on 62464 or at Contract Schoolwear, Farnworth on 604529. Uniforms can also be purchased at Harrison's (on Blackburn Road) and Smart Clothing (Blackhorse Street) or on line at marksandspencer.com

- Black shoes - (not boots or trainers) with low heels
 - White or grey socks, or royal blue or grey tights.
 - Short or long grey trousers
 - Royal blue pinafore or skirt
 - Blue or yellow checked summer dress
 - Light blue shirt – formal shirt with button up neck and either short or long sleeves but not a polo shirt.
 - Tie – school tie in blue and gold (Tie on elastic for KS1 only)
 - V-necked cardigan or sweater with either the school logo and/or gold stripes at the neck and/or cuffs.
 - Optional reversible jacket in blue with logo.
- Trainers may be worn at playtimes.
- The wearing of jewellery is not allowed in school for health and safety reasons. This includes piercings of any nature.
- Long hair must be tied back, again for reasons of health and safety.

Games kit

- Black gym shoes, white socks, blue shadow stripe shorts, gold polo shirt with logo or without.
- Children in Years 1-6 should have an outdoor Games Kit. This should include trainers, dark coloured jogging/tracksuit pants, gold polo shirt and a blue or dark coloured jumper. Royal blue hoodies with school logo are available to order from the school office.
- Football kits are not allowed to be worn for PE or Sport Academy.
