Reading

Please ensure that you are reading with your child and exposing them to words on a daily basis. Record in the Reading Record every time you share your child's book with them or listen to them read. This is monitored in school. Reading books must be kept in your child's book bag and must be sent to school every day.

Tapestry and Home School Diaries

We are really pleased with all of the pictures and comments that parents have been uploading to tapestry and writing in home school diaries. It is lovely to see the children's progress and things they have been doing at home and sharing things we are doing in school. If you need any support in accessing Tapestry, please just call in to school.

Phonics

We are now approaching the end of phase 3 phonics and the children are really good at recalling the letters and sounds. Included in children's home school diaries are sound mats with all the phase 2 and 3 sounds, please practice these with your child along with the key words that are listed in the home school diary each week.

PE Kit

Please continue to encourage children to develop their independence skills when dressing for PE. We will be exploring the climbing apparatus in the hall and other climbing equipment. PE this half term will be on a Monday. Children also need to keep a waterproofs and wellies in school all year as we play out every day in ALL weather. We will inform you if they grow out of them.

Mathematics

This half term we will continue to explore different mathematical concepts, looking at addition and subtraction, solving problems and thinking about different numbers and how to represent them. We will also explore money, looking at different coins and amounts and how we use money.
