HOME LEARNING GRIDS

We are trialling our new home learning system this half term. Your child will have a 'Home Learning Grid' in their research log which has a combination of compulsory and optional activities that they can do over the half term. They should put any activities they do in their home school diary. In Autumn they will be given a new Home Learning Book. If you have any questions then please just call in and ask! Reading

Please ensure that you are reading with your child and exposing them to words on a daily basis. Record in the Reading Record every time you share your child's book with them or listen to them read. This is monitored in school. Reading books must be kept in your child's book bag and must be sent to school every day. Children are encouraged to change their books daily.

Key Words

We will focus lots on reading and writing key words as these form the basis for lots of reading and writing. The words are in the Home School Diary and also the back of the Home Reading Record.

Mathematics

This half term we will continue to focusing on problem solving across lots of different areas of maths. We will also explore counting in 2's, 5's and 10's in lots of fun and practical ways. The basics of accurate counting are still so important and we will continue with this also.

Summer – Outdoor Learning

The children in Reception access the outdoor learning environments everyday as part of their continuous provision. We are very lucky to have extended the outdoor provision to include a brand new play area in the 'quad' space in the center of the school building. As the weather gets warmer, it is important that children wear sun-cream and that they bring a hat into school. School caps are available from the school office (£6 for 1 or £10 for 2).
