## Class Call-In

At The Oaks, we have an open-door policy so you can call in at any time if you need to speak to your child's class teacher. If they are not available they will arrange a time to meet with you. We will also be having a class call in on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> September from 3.30pm – 4.15pm**, where you can have a look at your child's new classroom and get to meet their new teachers.

## Phonics 2019!

The Phonics Tests will be held in June 2019. These are informal statutory assessments which will assess your child's phonological knowledge. They are very informal and led by the class teacher.

## NEW Behaviour System

As a school we are using a different system to address poor behaviour. Children will be given a warning for poor or disruptive behaviour. If their behaviour does not improve their name will be written on the board. If poor behaviour continues further, they will be given a 'red card' and miss 10 minutes of their lunch time for 'reflection time'. Any child that receives more than one red card in a week will get a phone call home to inform parents. Children are rewarded for good behaviour with house points, Oak Leaf Rewards and Certificates of Achievement.

## PE Kit

Children must have their indoor and outdoor PE kit in school at all times. They also need to keep a pair of wellies in school.

## HOME READING

In Year 1 children will no longer bring their Oxford Reading Tree Guided Reading book home. Each child will be given 2 home reading books at a time, which will be allocated based upon the reading level that they are working at. Children are to read both books at home and then change them themselves when they need new books. Children are expected to read their **2 books each week as a minimum**. Your child will be moved onto the next level as and when the teacher feels that they are ready. It will be noted in their record which stage they are reading. Thank you for your support with this.
