NEWSLETTERS

Trips & Visitors

This half term Year 1 will be doing lots of outdoor learning and will have a paleontologist day, dressing up as explorers and carrying out exciting activities.

READING!

It is extremely important that your child continues to read at home EVERYDAY. It is important that you discuss the book and ask questions to improve their understanding. Children should log each time that they read. This is monitored in school.

Maths and English

In Maths, we will be learning all about multiplication and division. We will be focusing on counting in groups of 2, 5 and 10. You can practice maths at home with your child by completing activities in their Maths Challenge books. In English this half term we will be focusing on non-fiction writing and stories about dinosaurs. You can help your child by reading dinosaur stories and asking them questions about what they have read.

Phonics Screening

In the summer term, your child will have a phonics screening test. This is a statutory assessment where the children will be assessed on their phonological knowledge. This will be done in an informal manner within a normal school day. Please do not worry about the assessment and if you have any questions just pop in and ask!
