HOME LEARNING GRIDS

We are trialling our new home learning system this half term. Your child will have a 'Home Learning Grid' in their research log which has a combination of compulsory and optional activities that they can do over the half term. They should do these activities in their Research Log for the summer, then in Autumn they will be given a new Home Learning Book. We are also changing the 'Project Overview' to a 'Knowledge Organiser'. This will contain key information and facts to help your child with their upcoming project. Trips & Visitors

This half term Year 1 will be visiting Chester Zoo to see 13 life-sized animatronic **PREDATORS** in the world premiere exhibition from the creators of Dinosaurs! We will also have a dinosaur day and carry out lots of activities.

Maths and English

In Maths, we will be learning all about position and direction, time and place value. You can practice maths at home with your child by talking about time, showing them on an analogue clock what time it is at different times of the day.

In English this half term we will be focusing on writing riddles and stories about dinosaurs. You can help your child by reading dinosaur stories and asking them questions about what they have read.

End of Year Assessments

In June the children will be taking part in end of year assessment tests in English and Maths. These tests will be used to support teacher assessments, which take into account how your child performs on a day to day basis. Test scores will be reported on your child's end of year report.

Phonics Screening

This term your child will have a phonics screening test. This is a statutory assessment where the children will be assessed on their phonological knowledge. This will be done in an informal manner within a normal school day. Please do not worry about the assessment and if you have any questions just pop in and ask!
