HOME LEARNING GRIDS

We are trialling our new home learning system this half term. SATS

Your child completed the year 2 SATS papers throughout May. These tests will be used to support teacher assessments, which take into account how your child performs on a day-to-day basis. Tests scores will be reported on your child's end of year report.

English & Maths

This half term in English we will be writing non fiction texts such as explanation texts and a recount of our trip to Blackpool. Your child could write a diary at home to help with this style of writing. Please ensure that your child also continues to read at home on a daily basis – this is monitored in school. In Maths, we will be looking at measurement and doing lots of mathematical problem solving. Please continue to practice these key skills at home including logging on to Times Table Rockstars.
