HOME LEARNING GRIDS

We are trialling our new home learning system this half term. Your child will have a 'Home Learning Grid' in their research log which has a combination of compulsory and optional activities that they can do over the half term. They should do these activities in their Research Log for the summer, then in Autumn they will be given a new Home Learning Book. We are also changing the 'Project Overview' to a 'Knowledge Organiser'. This will contain key information and facts to help your child with their upcoming project. English & Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on writing advertisement posters as well as character and setting descriptions. You could practice writing in this style with your child at home. In Maths, we will be recapping on the written methods that we have learnt this year, as well as finding out about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. Please ensure that your child uses Times Tables Rockstars at home, this will support them in learning all of their times tables ready for Year 4. We will also be having Times Tables Leader Board in class over this half term as well as another battle with Year 4!

End of Year Assessments

In June the children will be taking part in end of year assessment tests in English and Maths. These tests will be used to support teacher assessments, which take into account how your child performs on a day to day basis. Test scores will be reported on your child's end of year report.

Year 3 will continue their swimming lessons at Sharples High School this half term. They will have their swimming lesson every Tuesday with the last session being on Tuesday 2nd July.
