English & Maths

In English this half term we will be focusing on writing myths and information texts. It is extremely important that your child continues to read on a daily basis. They should log each time that they read in their reading record. If children are not reading at home they will receive a red slip, where they will have to read to a teacher at a playtime.

In Maths we will be securing our knowledge of the written methods for multiplication and division. You can practice the written methods with your child at home. Look at the Calculations Policy on the website to ensure you are supporting them correctly.
