Interim Reports

Interim reports will be sent out at the end of January. These will provide you with a brief summary of where your child is working and the progress they are making so far this year. In January, children in Years 2 – 6 will be completing mid-year assessments – the interim report will provide you with a teacher assessment level as well as an attainment level from the mid-year assessments. READING!

It is extremely important that your child continues to read at home EVERY DAY. Reading books will continue to be sent home and you can also find a list of recommended reading books in the back of your child's Reading Record. Children should log each time that they read and this should be signed by parents. This is monitored in school.

English & Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on writing persuasive letters and writing poems. In reading lessons we will continue to skim, scan and close read. Spellings need to be practiced at home regularly through the week.

In Maths, we will be focusing on fractions, measure and solving 2 step problems. At home, please continue to practice mental maths with your child including mental addition and subtraction and their times tables.

Class Novel

This half term, Year 4 will be continuing the novel 'Varjak Paw'.

Times Tables Rockstars

All children have a log in for Times Tables Rockstars. They can access this from tablets and computers at home. Please encourage your child to go on this as it will really support them in learning their times tables and their progress is rewarded in school.
