Your teaching assistants this year are Mrs Cullen and Miss Hart. This half term your project is 'Roaming Romans'. Please see the overview for specific information that the project will involve. Your child will also have a new Research Log sheet with ideas of research that they can complete at home. We regularly update the school website with pictures of children's learning. Remember to check it to see what your child has been doing in school!

English & Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on writing diary entries, information texts and leaflets.

Remember that to become a fluent reader, it is very important that your child continues to read on a daily basis. They should log each time that they read in their reading record. Red slips will be given out to children who are not reading regularly enough.

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on fractions, percentages and decimals as well as revising Roman numerals. In Year 5 children should be secure with the written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. You can practice these with your child at home. Look at the Calculations Policy on the website to ensure you are supporting them correctly.
