Interim Reports

Interim reports will be sent out at the end of January. These will provide you with a brief summary of where your child is working and the progress they are making so far this year. READING!

It is extremely important that your child continues to read at home EVERYDAY. Reading books will continue to be sent home and you can also find a list of recommended reading books in the back of your child's Reading Record. Children should log each time that they read and this should be signed by parents. This is monitored in school.

English & Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on writing newspaper reports and balanced arguments. You could practice writing these genres with your child at home. In Maths, we will be focusing on fractions and recapping on the written methods that we have already learnt. At home, please continue to practice mental maths with your child including mental addition and subtraction and their times tables.

This half term we will be having a Zoolab workshop on the 7th February. We will meet some animals and learn about the rainforest.
