Telling the Time

It is extremely important that children know how to tell the time on both an analogue and digital clock. Please support your child with this by frequently asking them to tell you the time. Children are allowed to wear a simple watch to school. Wearing an analogue watch will make all the difference to them learning to tell the time.

English & Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on writing mystery stories and how the author creates suspense. You could practice writing these genres with your child at home. In Maths, we will be focusing on decimals and time. At home, please continue to practice mental maths with your child including mental addition and subtraction and their times tables.
