NEW Behaviour System

As a school we are using a different system to address poor behaviour. Children will be given a warning for poor or disruptive behaviour. If their behaviour does not improve their name will be written on the board. If poor behaviour continues further, they will be given a 'red card' and miss 20 minutes of their lunch time for 'reflection time'. Any child that receives more than one red card in a week will get a phone call home to inform parents. Children are rewarded for good behaviour with house points, Oak Leaf Rewards and Certificates of Achievement.
