The SAT's will be held week beginning 13th May 2019. These are statutory tests that the children must complete. Please ensure that you do not book any holidays during this time!

Interim Reports

Interim reports will be sent out at the end of January. These will provide you with a brief summary of where your child is working and the progress they are making so far this year. In January, children in Years 2 – 6 will be completing mid-year assessments – the interim report will provide you with a teacher assessment level as well as an attainment level from the mid-year assessments. Please also remember that at The Oaks, we have an open-door policy so you can call in at any time if you need to speak your child's class teacher. English and Maths

This half term in English we will be focusing on reading and writing journalistic reports and short stories with flashbacks. In Maths, we will be learning more about measures, ratio and proportion. We will also be applying our written methods when solving problems and reasoning.

Reading books will continue to be sent home and you can also find a list of recommended reading books in the back of your child's Reading Record. Children should log each time that they read and this should be signed by parents. This is monitored in school.

All children have a log in for Times Tables Rockstars. They can access this from tablets and computers at home. Please encourage your child to go on this as it will really support them in learning their times tables.
