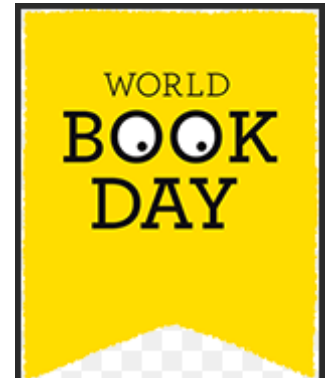

Top Tips

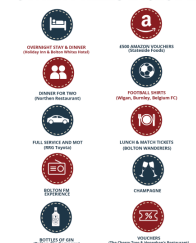
