Please also regularly check your children's activity online and ensure they are not posting anything inappropriate.

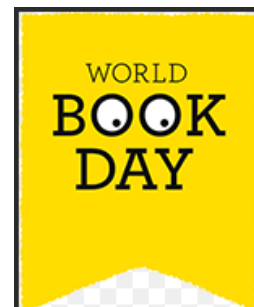
