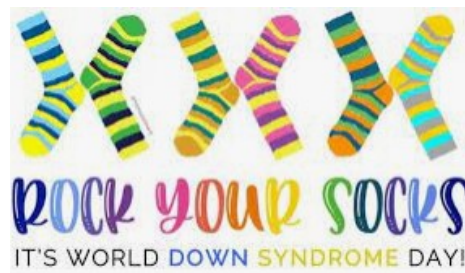
## Who are our Governors?
