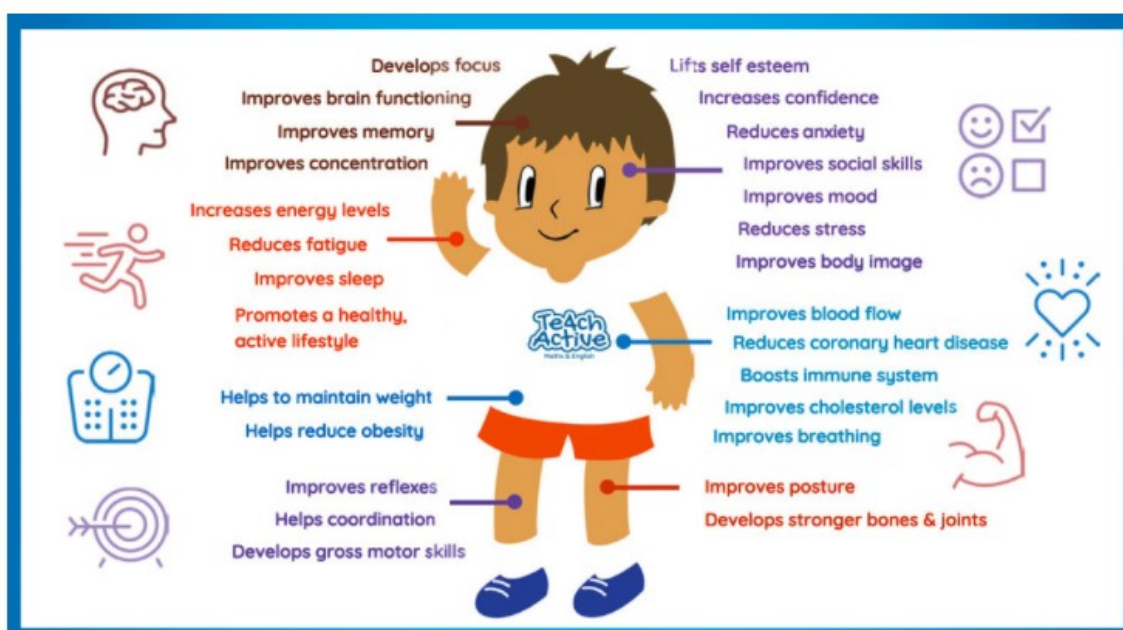


Life Saving CPR Day ~ Friday 17th December
