<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Explore your school reading book and any other books you have at home with a grown up or a brother or sister in your house. Look at the pictures and see if you can predict what is happening. <p><u>Getting dressed and undressed</u></p> <p>Can you practice your dressing skills? Time yourself to see how fast you can get dressed. Are some clothes easier than others? Can you have a go at zipping up your coat?</p>		<p><u>Numbers</u></p> <p>Go on a number hunt at your house. Where can you see numbers? Which room has the most numbers? Practice your counting skills by finding different things in your house to count such as stairs, lights or socks.</p>
<p><u>Family Picture</u></p> <p>Can you draw a picture of all the people in your family? Think carefully about the sizes of people, who is the tallest and who is the shortest. Can you draw the little features like eyelashes and eyebrows?</p>	<p><u>Nursery Rhymes</u></p> <p>Sing some nursery rhymes with a grown up or a brother or sister. Think about your favourite nursery rhyme, can you draw a picture of it? Can you hear any rhyming words in nursery rhymes, ask a grown up to help you!</p>	<p><u>Cosmic Kids Yoga</u></p> <p>Explore Cosmic Kids yoga and practise your relaxing and movement skills. Listen really carefully to the instructions and see if you can copy the moves.</p>
