Home Reading

It is extremely important that your child is exposed to words and books on a daily basis so that they develop the language and comprehension skills required to access the primary curriculum. Reading books will be provided after the first full week of settling into school. New reading books will then be sent home on a Monday and Thursday. Please log in the Reading Record every time you listen to your child read. This is monitored in school and children receive house points for regular home reading.

Reading books must be kept in your child's book bag, which needs to be sent to school every day.

Half Term Focus

This half term our project is called 'All About Me'. We will be focusing on getting to know the children and their skills, and ensuring that they are settled, happy and developing new friendships in school.

Tapestry

All Reception parents will receive login details to be able to log on to the online learning journey 'Tapestry'. You will be able to see pictures and observations of your child's learning in school. Waterproofs & Wellies

Remember to send waterproofs and wellies into school with your child so that they can enjoy outdoor play even when it is wet! These will stay in school so please make sure that they are labelled with your child's name!
