Learn weekly spellings and play on Spelling Shed	Year 5 Home Learning Grid Autumn 2	Look at and discuss your Knowledge Organiser with an adult
Practise times tables weekly on Times Table Rockstars	Create a fact file about what life was like during Anglo Saxon or Viking times, using a mixture of pictures and writing to make your work stand out.	Read at least 4 times per week to an adult
Research the famous Viking gods, and then make your own Top Trump cards to compare them.	Write your own newspaper report about a famous Viking battle or The Battle of Hastings. Can you think of a catchy headline?	Draw a timeline to show where the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings fit with the history topics you have studied before and include the main events of this period.
Using a mental method, practise converting grams to kilograms and millilitres to litres. You could even apply your skills at home by doing some baking!	Design your own Viking themed board game and then play against somebody at home.	Practise using written methods for multiplication and division. See if you can write your own word problem and choose the right calculation to solve it.
