Home Reading

Children are expected to read at home on a daily basis. Children will be moved up to the next reading level once they are reading the level that they are on with confidence, and can show a good understanding of the texts. Ensure that you are asking your child questions about the vocabulary in the book and please make notes in the reading record about anything you may have discussed with your child. This is always really useful in school. Parents must sign the Reading Record to acknowledge that your child has read - Reading Records are checked every Friday.

Class Novel

This half term we will be reading The Train to Impossible Places by P.G. Bell as our class novel.

Maths & English

In English this half term, we will be focusing on writing myths and legends as well as war poetry.

In Maths we will be focusing on the written methods for multiplication and division. We will also be learning about shapes and measures - this is to cover the learning that was missed due to the school closure in the summer term.

You can support your child at home by ensuring that they go on Times Tables Rockstars. The children will find it difficult to access the Y5 maths curriculum if they are not fluent at their times tables

REMOTE LEARNING

In the event that either your child has to isolate for 14 days or the whole class, it is now law that they must complete learning at home whilst isolating, providing they are fit and well to do so. This will be provided by school on a daily basis. Remote learning activities will be uploaded to SeeSaw daily therefore it is important that both you and your child can access their Seesaw account.

In the event of isolating at home and the class being in school your child will be sent log in details so that they can Zoom in to some specific lessons for their teaching input. This has worked very well for a number of children who have had to isolate already. In the event of whole class isolation, Miss Shaw and Miss Copeland will host Zoom meetings each day with the children to deliver the learning input or to inform them of the day's activities. Children **must** attend these Zoom sessions. Zoom details will always be sent to your child via SeeSaw and email.
