Learn all the multiplication tables up to 12 x 12. Use Times Table Rockstars, Hit the Button and TimesTables.me.uk to practise.	Create an information text about an Italian tourist attraction.	Read at least 4 times per week to an adult. Discuss new vocabulary with an adult at home.
Learn some Italian phrases. You could practise counting or naming the days of the week in Italian.	Make a model of your favourite pizza or ice-cream.	Learn how to cook an Italian dish. You could take a photo or film yourself making it and post it on Seesaw.
Make your own Roman artefact e.g. a shield, pot, mosaic or piece of jewellery.	Create an A to Z of Italy or The Romans.	Find out what it was like to live in Roman times.
