MEET THE TEACHERS!

Your teacher in Year 4 this year is Mrs Robertson and supported by Miss Ralph. The children will work in groups throughout each morning to ensure that we can fill all the gaps for any learning that may have been missed during the summer term and meeting all of the children's needs. We are really excited to welcome everybody back! As children return we will be focusing on re-phasing the children back to school life, ensuring they are happy and settled. We will be having a strong focus on PSHE and well-being as a whole school.

Home Reading

It is extremely important that your child continues to read at home EVERY DAY. We have introduced a new KS2 reading scheme and your child will be allocated a book from an appropriate level from this scheme. They will have this book alongside a longer novel to support their stamina for reading. Children must log each time that they read in their Reading Record and parents must sign Reading Records.

Project

In the first week back we will be doing a mini-project about our responsibility as world citizens, linked to the book 'Here We Are'.

Our first main project is 'Pharaohs and Pyramids'. We will be learning about Ancient Egyptians.

Maths & English

In English this half term, our writing focus will be on the basic skills of using punctuation correctly, structuring sentences accurately, and joining letters. In Maths we will be focusing on Place Value and written methods.

COVID 19

To support the children with the learning that they have missed due to the school closure, we will be having some additional Maths and English sessions, focusing on Shape, Space and Measures in Maths and Basic reading and Writing Skills in English. Your child will receive a knowledge organiser with the key facts that they need to know to support them with this area of Maths.

PE Kit

Our PE days will be on a Monday and Wednesday. Your child must come to school in their PE kit on those days and they will stay in their kit for the full day. If the weather is cold, they may wear joggers, their PE t-shirt and an Oaks hoody. If your child does not have an Oaks hoody, a plain, dark coloured top is fine.

Statutory Multiplication Tables Check

By the end of Year 4, it is expected that children know all of their times tables and corresponding division facts, up to 12×12 . In June 2021 your child will take part in the Multiplication Tables Check. This is a statutory test that all schools must take part in. The test will be informal and carried out on a computer.

Please support your child with learning their times tables at home and encourage them to go on Times Tables Rockstars as much as possible.
