Times Tables

It is a national expectation that children know their times tables by the end of Year 4. If they do not know their times tables they will find it very difficult to access the upper KS2 maths curriculum. Please ensure that your child is using Times Tables Rockstars regularly. This is monitored in school.

Maths & English

In English this half term, we will be focusing on writing explanation texts and we will also be completing narrative writing linked to our text 'Varmints'. We will also be developing our proof-reading and editing skills. In Maths we will be focusing on the written methods for multiplication and division. We will also be learning about area and fractions.

REMOTE LEARNING

In the event that either your child has to isolate for 14 days or the whole class, it is now law that they must complete learning at home whilst isolating, providing they are fit and well to do so. This will be provided by school on a daily basis. Remote learning activities will be uploaded to SeeSaw daily therefore it is important that both you and your child can access their Seesaw account.

In the event of isolating at home and the class being in school your child will be sent log in details so that they can Zoom in to some specific lessons for their teaching input. This has worked very well for a number of children who have had to isolate already. In the event of whole class isolation, Mrs Robertson and Miss Ralph will host Zoom meetings each day with the children to deliver the learning input or to inform them of the day's activities. Children **must** attend these Zoom sessions. Zoom details will always be sent to your child via SeeSaw.

Trout

During the second week in January, 100 trout eggs will be delivered to school! We will be observing and feeding them, recording their growth and lots more. In March, the whole class will release the trout into Eagley Brook river.
