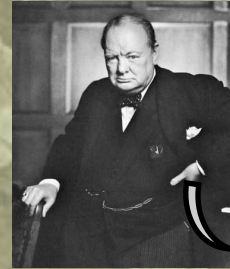


When the Bombs Fell

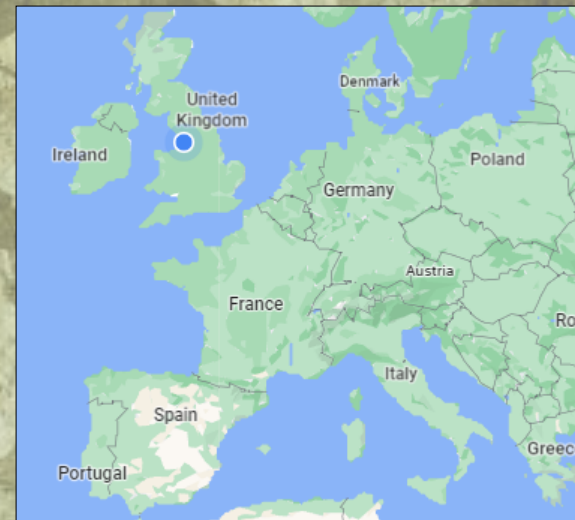
Vocabulary	Definition
allied powers	the countries who joined together to fight the axis powers (Britain, France and the USA)
evacuee	a child sent from their home to live in the safety of the countryside during The Blitz
The Holocaust	the killing of millions of Jews by members of the Nazi party during WW2
rationing	a limit on the amount of food people could buy during the war
The Blitz	a series of heavy air raid bomb attacks on major British cities
propaganda	information which is deliberately spread to influence the public
air raid shelter	an underground structure designed to protect people from an air raid

Neville Chamberlain	Prime Minister during the outbreak of WW2.
Winston Churchill	Prime Minister for most of the war.
Adolf Hitler	Leader of Nazi Germany.

1939

Britain declares war on Germany.

1940 & 1941

The Blitz attacks happen over Britain

1945

WWII ends. Victory is declared on the 8th May (VE Day)
